The Anaheim Transportation Network (ATN) plans to provide transportation service to select Costa Mesa destinations to accommodate reciprocal service and to facilitate transportation services for commuters.

Costa Mesa destinations may include, but are not limited to, South Coast Plaza and Segerstrom Center for the Arts. Routes would include service along Bristol Street, Anton Blvd., and Avenue of the ARTS.

Operating hours are assumed to average approximately five (5) hours per day.

Service frequency will be approximately (3) three times per day.

Service operation to Costa Mesa is slated to begin in the second quarter of 2015.

The public hearing shall be for the purpose of considering service expansion for the Anaheim Resort Transportation system. No changes in the regular fare structure are proposed.

NEW PROPOSED ART LINE, COSTA MESA/SOUTH COAST PLAZA LINE -- SERVICE BETWEEN THE ANAHEIM RESORT DISTRICT/ARTIC AND THE CITY OF COSTA MESA

The proposed new service is being considered to improve travel options and connectivity between major Orange County destinations and service for the employees of the Anaheim Resort and Costa Mesa business establishments. Information regarding the specific bus route alignments and proposed bus stop locations will be presented at the Public Hearing.

The purpose of the Public Hearing is to inform the public about the project, and encourage the public to comment and participate. Maps, drawings, and other pertinent information, will be available for public inspection. During the Public Hearing the public will be able to discuss the project in an informal manner with the Anaheim Transportation Network's officials. Comments will become part of the official public hearing record. The comments will be considered when making future project related decisions.
