In an apprenticeship/training capacity, performs bus and subsystem maintenance and repair functions. Performs diagnosis, and repairs of bus systems, subsystems and assemblies requiring light, moderate, and advanced mechanical work.

- Cleans tools and work area.
- Submits work summaries to Trainer

- Identify and inspect automotive or diesel engines, transmissions and other parts.
- Clean and service equipment.
- Dismantle and reassemble equipment or parts and make mechanical repairs of average difficulty.

- Must possess a Class C driver's license.
- Required to provide a DMV H6 printout (or equivalent if out-of-state) upon request. Must have a good DMV record in accordance with company standards.
- Must have the ability to obtain a Class B license with no air brake restrictions and Passenger (P) endorsement within the introductory period (training will be provided)
- Applicant is required to present a Class B driver's permit upon date of hire.
