The Anaheim Transportation Network (ATN) is developing the ANNA Multimodal Transit Plan to promote healthy and equitable communities for Anaheim neighborhoods, including The Anaheim Resort and Platinum Triangle districts.

ANNA — Advancing Neighborhood Networks for All — will increase the ways that Anaheim’s residents, employees, and visitors can travel.

The plan will explore alternative choices like active transportation options (walking, biking, scooters), and technology options such as bus rapid transit (BRT), streetcar, micro-transit, and automated vehicles that could offer more seamless and enjoyable travel experiences.

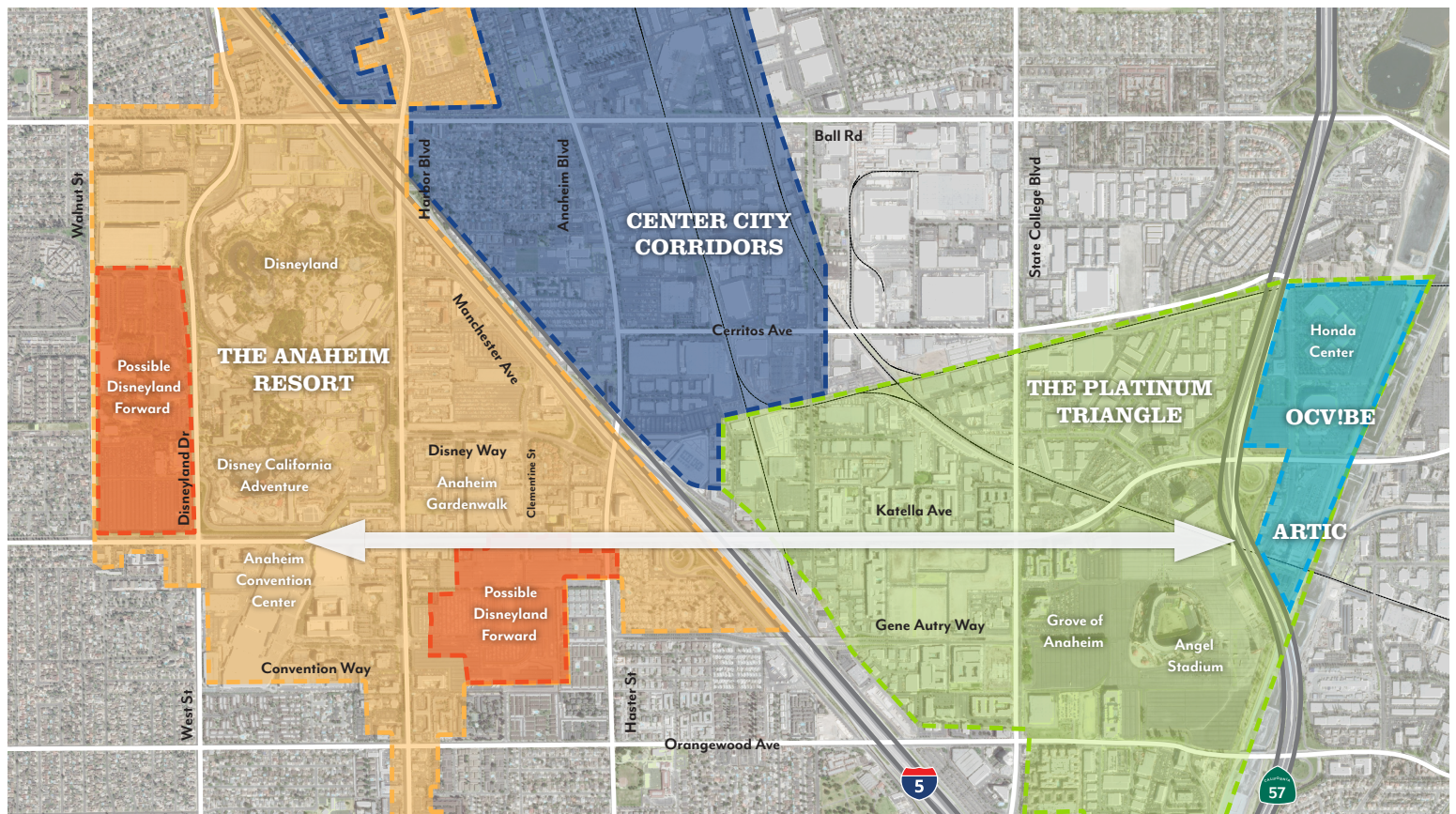

Information gathered through community and stakeholder meetings, pop-up events, and survey responses will be analyzed as part of the ANNA Multimodal Transit Plan. The plan is anticipated to be completed in August 2023.
