SPECIAL NOTICE REGARDING COVID-19

On March 4, 2020, Governor Newsom proclaimed a State of Emergency in California as a result of the threat of COVID-19. On March 17, 2020, Governor Newsom issued Executive Order N-29-20 (superseding the Brown Actrelated provisions of Executive Order N-25-20 issued on March 12, 2020), which allows a local legislative body to hold public meetings via teleconferencing and to make public meetings accessible telephonically or otherwise electronically to all members of the public seeking to observe and to address the local legislative body. ADDITIONS/DELETIONS TO THE AGENDA: Finding that there is a need to take immediate action and that the need for action came to the attention of the ATN Board subsequent to the agenda being posted, a 2/3 vote being required.

Testimony during public hearings is not subject to the three-minute time limit but speakers are encouraged to be brief. The Chairperson may limit the length of comments during public hearings due to the number of persons wishing to speak or if comments become repetitious or irrelevant. Pursuant to Government Code Section 54954.2(a)(2), no action or discussion by the Anaheim Transportation Network shall be undertaken on any item not appearing on the posted agenda, except to briefly provide information, ask for clarification, provide direction to staff, or schedule a matter for a future meeting.

- 2. Authorize ATN Executive Director to transfer up to \$400,000 from reserve funds in support of ATN operational needs, if necessary. Direct ATN Executive Director to repay reserve funds upon receipt of relief funds from federal and/or other funding sources;
- 3. In support of proposed recovery strategies, authorize Executive Director to negotiate a zero percent line of credit from Anaheim Tourism Assessment District (ATID) Transportation Committee in amount not to exceed \$1.5 Million; and
- 4. Authorize ATN Executive Director to amend funding agreement with Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) for the receipt of CARES Act Transit Relief Funds from Federal Transit Administration
