Public hearings, if scheduled, will commence at the start of the meeting unless otherwise noted. Public comments are limited to three (3) minutes per speaker, unless otherwise specified by the Chairperson. Public hearing testimony is not subject to the three-minute limit, though speakers are encouraged to be concise.

Electronic Participation: Public comments may also be submitted electronically in advance at rideart.org/public comments. Comments received prior to the start of the meeting will be distributed to the Board of Directors and made part of the official record.

The Chairperson reserves the right to limit the length of comments during public hearings, if necessary, due to the number of speakers or if comments become repetitive or irrelevant. Pursuant to Government Code Section 54954.2(a)(2), no action or discussion shall be taken on any item not appearing on the posted agenda, except to brief information, clarification, direction to staff, or to schedule a matter for a future agenda.




